Aug 1838	ticket-of-leave for the Newcastle district
1840	obtained permission to marry Mary Corcoran at Newcastle
1841	Married Mary Corcoran at Christchurch, Newcastle
July 1841	working for John Eales for 12 months on the Darling Downs
Nov 1844	ticket-of-leave altered to the Moreton Bay district
May 1846	second class Conditional Pardon
July 1851	Obtained title to land at Ipswich jointly with his brother
